SUPPLY CHAIN OVERVIEW

V-Advices' supply chain is mandated to provide optimal value-added procurement services that are legal, responsible, verifiable, ethical, of the best quality, environmentally and socially responsible, cost-effective, and meet all regulatory requirements and ISO compliance.

V-Advices will avoid situations that may appear to be based on personal favoritism or other factors unrelated to **V-Advices' interests**. Decisions will reflect our best judgment based on a supplier's technology, quality, responsiveness, delivery capabilities, and cost. The supplier's financial stability, environmental performance, responsible sourcing, diversity, and track record are other factors that will be considered.

V-ADVICES SUPPLIERS

V-Advices' relationships with suppliers are of great strategic importance. We use common sense and the highest standards of integrity in working with suppliers. **V-Advices expects** its suppliers to act with uncompromising integrity and follow all appropriate global and regional laws and regulations. This also includes all V-Advices policies and programs aligned with these requirements.

Laws are changing worldwide. To meet these requirements, providers must maintain governance and management systems to facilitate their compliance program. Suppliers must have the necessary documentation to demonstrate compliance. Mechanisms should also be established to determine and manage risks in all areas outlined in this document and its own code of conduct. Suppliers must also have adequate systems to conduct due diligence with their suppliers. Any identified risks should be reported immediately in writing to **V-Advices**. Suppliers must implement appropriate business continuity plans for all operations supporting **V-Advices**.

SUPPLIER REQUIREMENTS







QUALITY

V-Advices is committed to providing high-quality, safe, and reliable products and services; therefore, we ensure that we consistently meet or exceed the standards set out in our **policy** and the applicable global quality manufacturing standards.

At **V-Advices**, we know that our customers depend not only on our state-of-the-art products and services but also on the superior quality that underpins all our products, services, and support. That's why we ensure, through our Quality Management System (QMS), that our products and services are delivered at the level and quality our customers expect. One of **V-Advices**' commitments to quality is to ensure that quality requirements are set for suppliers, partners, and contractors and hold them accountable for complying with them.

Suppliers must have a documented quality management system aligned to ISO 9001 or a similar standard. For IT security and IT, the system must be ISO27001 or a similar standard.

ENVIRONMENT AND SUSTAINABILITY

V-Advices is committed to conducting business in an environmentally responsible manner. We are committed to complying with all applicable laws, regulations, and policies regarding environmental protection, conservation of energy and natural resources, and reducing the environmental impact of our operations worldwide. This commitment is consistent with our business objectives and **policy** and is essential to the company's continued success.

V-Advices informs suppliers and contractors of its environmental requirements and asks them to align their practices with our expectations ¹. Suppliers must comply with all applicable local environmental laws and regulations.

Since its foundation, V-Advices has been committed to sustainability and environmental protection. The company has aligned its goals with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals.² and the Science-Based Goals Initiative (SBTi). V-Advices has committed to achieving net-zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050. V-Advices is committed to attaining interim greenhouse gas reduction targets to ensure the company achieves its net-zero emissions targets. By 2030, V-Advices will reduce absolute Scope 1 and 2 emissions by 50% and Scope 3 emissions by at least 30% compared to the 2019 base year. Both net-zero and intermediate commitments have been validated and approved by the Science Based Targets Initiative (SBTI), a global body aiming to enable companies to set ambitious emissions reduction targets in line with the latest climate science. The goal is to accelerate companies worldwide to halve emissions by 2030 and reach net-zero emissions before 2050.

Working with suppliers to achieve our Scope 3 emissions reduction targets is critical to this success.

Suppliers must have a documented environmental management system or program aligned with ISO 14001.

V-Advices expects suppliers to conserve natural resources by reducing water use, energy consumption, greenhouse gas emissions, and waste management/minimizing.

V-Advices expects suppliers to adopt practices in line with net zero greenhouse gas emissions, disclose their data, and show their progress. Suppliers must have decarbonization targets/targets set by 2035.

Suppliers are required to report sustainability-related progress in line with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (UN SDGs) using voluntary platforms such as the S&P Global Corporate Sustainability Assessment, EcoVadis, Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) report, Carbon Disclosure Project (CDP), or similar.

V-Advices' commitment is to net zero emissions and how we will work with our suppliers to achieve our decarbonization goals mutually.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

V-Advices is committed to providing a healthy and safe working environment and processes that enable our employees to work without injury and illness, acting responsibly towards the environment. To comply with **the Policy, V-Advices informs** suppliers and contractors of **V-Advices' health and safety** principles and asks them to align their practices with our expectations. Suppliers must comply with all applicable health and safety laws and regulations.

Suppliers and contractors must adopt practices that align with **V-Advices' environmental, health, and safety principles** and have a documented health and safety management system or program that is aligned with ISO 45001 or similar.

HUMAN RIGHTS AND LABOR PRACTICES

V-Advices' core values and culture reflect a commitment to ethical business practices and good corporate citizenship wherever we operate. As a company, we recognize and abide by the core principles contained in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and ³our policies and practices reflect our commitment to promoting human rights within the company's sphere of influence.

The components and services for our products⁴ come from suppliers in different countries worldwide, each with its laws and regulations. We are committed to respecting human rights throughout our global supply chain and do not knowingly conduct business with individuals or companies that participate in child exploitation (including child labor), physical punishment, forced labor, or human trafficking.

Suppliers must comply with all.⁵ applicable labor laws, rules, and regulations, including, but not limited to, all laws prohibiting the solicitation, facilitation, or any other use of slavery, child labor, or ⁶ Human trafficking.

ANTI-CORRUPTION AND BRIBERY

V-Advices is committed to conducting its business activities in accordance with all applicable laws and regulations prohibiting bribery. We do not tolerate corruption in any form.

V-Advices has aligned its procedures and practices to comply with the following requirements and expects its suppliers to follow the appropriate laws and regulations.

V-Advices providers must comply with all applicable anti-corruption laws, rules, and regulations (global and local), including the US Foreign Corrupt Practices Act.⁷, the Bribery Act ⁸⁹And those enacted under the OECD Convention on Combating Bribery of Foreign Public Officials¹⁰ in International Business Transactions. Policies and procedures should be put in place to ensure compliance.

LEGISLATION

RESPONSIBLE MINERALS

V-Advices supports ending violence, human rights violations, and environmental devastation in the countries concerned. We are committed to complying with all requirements applicable to our company under the Conflict Minerals Rule. We are also committed to sourcing components and materials from organizations that share our values of human rights, ethics, and environmental responsibility. **V-Advices' suppliers** must understand and comply with these requirements and ensure that they provide V-Advices with materials that are "DRC (Democratic Republic of Congo) Conflict Free." **V-Advices** complies with the US Dodd-Frank Act.¹¹, known as the "Conflict Minerals Rule."

V-Advices expects suppliers to provide **V-Advices** with "DRC Conflict-Free" materials and adopt policies and management systems for conflict minerals to ensure Conflict-Free supply chains. V-Advices will regularly request the Conflict Minerals Reporting Template (CMRT) from your company and expects a full version to be provided upon request.

ROHS

⁷The Foreign Corrupt Practices Act of 1977 (FCPA) is a US federal law known primarily for two significant provisions: one addressing accounting transparency requirements under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and another regarding bribery of foreign officials. The main goal of the Foreign Corrupt Practices Act (FCPA) is to prohibit companies and their officials from influencing foreign officials with personal payments or rewards.

⁸ The Corruption Act 2010 (c.23) is an Act of the UK Parliament that governs criminal law relating to corruption. The Act repeals all previous statutory and common law provisions about corruption, replacing them with the offenses of bribery, bribery, foreign public officials, and failure of a business organization to prevent bribery on its behalf.

¹⁰ The OECD Anti-Corruption Convention (officially Convention on Combating Bribery of Foreign Public Officials in International Business Transactions) is an OECD anti-corruption convention aimed at reducing political corruption and corporate crime in developing countries by encouraging sanctions against bribery in international business transactions carried out by companies based in countries that are members of the Convention. It aims to create a level playing field in today's global business environment. The Convention requires adherents to criminalize acts of offering or bribery but not to solicit or receive bribes.

¹¹ USA - The Dodd-Frank Act, known as the "Conflict Minerals Rule," requires publicly traded companies to report the presence of conflict minerals in manufactured products annually. Conflict minerals are defined as tin, tungsten, tantalum, and gold ("3TG") originating in the Democratic Republic of the Congo ("DRC") or neighboring countries ("Affected Countries"). Many other countries have adopted similar rules.







V-Advices **products** are designed for global compliance and meet RoHS requirements worldwide.¹². To ensure compliance with our products, **V-Advices** requires the full declaration of all restricted or prohibited substances in any part provided to **V-Advices**, including the use of any exemptions or waivers. **V-Advices** requires all parts supplied to comply with all current EU RoHS, China RoHS, UAE RoHS, and Saudi Arabia RoHS requirements.

V-Advices requires suppliers to fully disclose the use of any hazardous substances above the permitted RoHS directive and the use of any exemptions from Annex III or Annex IV of the EU RoHS Directive for each part provided to **V-Advices**.

OBJECTIVES

V-Advices supports the restriction of chemicals and the substitution of unnecessary hazardous chemicals and is committed to eliminating Substances of Very High Concern (SVHCs) if possible or otherwise communicating the presence of SVHCs in our supply chains.

V-Advices expects all parts and chemicals supplied to **V-Advices** to be free of substances listed in Annex XIV or EU REACH. V-Advices requires notification of all products supplied that do not meet this requirement.

V-Advices requires that all products containing substances listed in Annex XVII of the EU REACH Regulation comply with the conditions of the restrictions. **V-Advices** requires notification of all products supplied to **V-Advices** containing any of these substances.

V-Advices requires suppliers to fully disclose all products containing substances of very high concern (SVHCs) listed in the REACH Appendices also available at: https://echa.europa.eu/candidate-list-table) present in any item over 0.1% (w/w) of each part supplied.

Suppliers should know that REACH is usually updated every 6 months and must refer to the latest version. The presence of any REACH substance must be reported at **regulatory@v-advices.com**

TOXIC SUBSTANCES CONTROL ACT (TSCA) PBT SUBSTANCES

As required by the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has enacted regulations to reduce exposure to certain persistent, bioaccumulative, and toxic chemicals (PBTs). These chemicals accumulate in the environment over time and can pose a potential risk to exposed populations. The rules restrict or prohibit the production (including import), processing, and/or commercial distribution (including in articles) of these PBT chemicals.

V-Advices requires suppliers to follow the "Regulation of Persistent, Bioaccumulative and Toxic Chemicals under Section 6(h) of the TSCA" and that all substances, including those with restriction dates published in the future, present in products supplied to **V-Advices** above the regulated concentration limits must be reported to **regulatory@v-advices.com**

The European Union (EU) Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS). Most Agilent products are classified within the EU RoHS Directive's categories as industrial monitoring and control equipment (category 9), and a limited number of Agilent products are classified as in vitro diagnostic medical devices (category 8).

CALIFORNIA PROPOSITION 65

California requires manufacturers placing products on the California market to provide a clear and reasonable warning to users exposed to products listed on the Proposition 65 list of chemicals.

V-Advices requires suppliers to report to **V-Advices** all supplied parts containing chemicals listed on the Proposition 65 Chemicals List. This information should be reported to **regulatory@v-advices.com**.

SUPPLY CHAIN SECURITY

TRADE COMPLIANCE

V-Advices is a European company required to comply with European trade sanctions and export control laws, including indirectly through its suppliers. **V-Advices** also comply with the import and export laws governing international transactions in each country in which it operates and, therefore, requires its suppliers to ensure compliance.

V-Advices expects suppliers to follow all applicable international import and export regulations. If necessary, suppliers must provide **V-Advices** with accurate information on the procurement of raw materials and components. They must also provide accurate information about the country of origin, tariff codes, export classification, and regulatory registration requirements upon request.

PRIVACY AND IT SECURITY

PRIVACY

At **V-Advices**, we recognize the importance of data protection and privacy. We are committed to acting in accordance with our values, in particular those of integrity and uncompromising responsibility, in handling personal data and to being responsible data stewards in this digital and global business environment. We expect the same from our suppliers.

Global privacy laws require **V-Advices to** enter into a Data Processing Agreement (DPA) with any provider that processes personal data on behalf of **V-Advices**. The DPA must include, where applicable, special contractual provisions to allow for the transfer of personal data outside of the home jurisdiction (e.g., EU and UK transfers of personal data require adherence to the standard contractual clauses incorporated by reference into any applicable DPA).

V-Advices has a global principles-based international program to address data protection and privacy, including a global data protection impact assessment process to conduct due diligence on new or changed uses of personal data in the event of the involvement of new suppliers who will handle personal data on behalf of V-Advices.

V-Advices expects suppliers to follow all applicable data protection and privacy laws worldwide and adopt the appropriate policies and procedures for their suppliers to ensure that all personal data processed for V-Advices is treated securely and in accordance with applicable laws.

Suppliers must also have DPAs in place with all their suppliers who have access to or otherwise process personal data in the provision of services to **V-Advices**.

CYBERSECURITY







Information management is vital to **V-Advices**. **V-Advices** has standard operating policies and procedures to maintain information confidentiality, security, integrity, and availability. These procedures include acceptable use of organizational requirements and apply to **V-Advices employees and non-employees**. The provisions also apply to all information and information processing facilities accessed, processed, communicated to, or operated by third parties and must be protected from misuse and unauthorized activity.

V-Advices expects suppliers to have policies and procedures aligned with these requirements, including any additional local or regional requirements.
